MAAC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

ANTHONY JOHNSON, FAIRFIELD

Senior, Center, 6-8, 240, Lake Wales, Fla./Lake Wales

Johnson, a senior center, averaged a double double in a pair of Fairfield wins this week, highlighted by a game-high 21-point performance against Sacred Heart on Sunday afternoon. He started the week with 16 points and 12 rebounds, eight of which came on the offensive glass, in a win against Holy Cross. In two games, Johnson shot 57 percent from the floor and recorded six blocks and four steals.

TYRONE LEWIS, NIAGARA

Senior, Guard, 5-11, 180, Levittown, Pa./Harry S. Truman

Lewis, a senior guard, had a record-breaking week, posting back-to-back 26-point performances for Niagara. Against Buffalo, he tied his career-high with six 3-pointers, en route to breaking the school's career record. Lewis connected on five 3-pointers in a 76-68 road victory at Illinois State, while shooting 8-for-15 from the floor and 5-for-9 from behind the arc. He became just the 11th Purple Eagle to eclipse the 1,500-point mark at Niagara in Sunday's win.

MAAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

KYLE SMYTH, IONA

Freshman, Guard, 6-4, 185, River Edge, N.J./Don Bosco Prep

Smyth, a freshman guard, led the Gaels in scoring in both Iona wins this week, netting 18 points vs. LIU and a career-high 21 in the victory over the BIGEAST's Providence. He averaged 15.7 points and 5.0 rebounds over the Gaels' three games this week and added seven assists. Smyth shot 15-of-21 (71.4%) from the field, 6-for-10 (60.0%) from beyond the arc and 11-for-13 (84.6%) from the free throw line. He had 18 points, five boards and five assists vs. Long Island, and 21 points and seven rebounds against Providence.

Canisius lost in its only game last week, falling at home to Bowling Green by a score of 58-54... The game against the Falcons was a "return game" from the 2009 ESPN BracketBuster game, which the Golden Griffins won on the road... Canisius is now 4-4 on the year, the first time the team has been .500 or better through eight games since 2003-04... Canisius junior **Julius Coles** scored a game-high 17 points in the loss to BGSU, the sixth time this season he has posted 15 or more points in the scoring column... Senior guard **Frank Turner** was good for 12 points and six assists on Saturday night... He has now scored in double figures for 27-straight games, which is the seventh-longest streak of its kind at the Division I level... Freshman **Alshwan Hymes** came off the bench to score nine points and pull down a career-high seven rebounds in 28 minutes of action... Six of Hymes' seven boards came off the offensive glass, and he also dished out a career-best three assists as well... Junior **Tomas Vazquez-Simmons** was credited with a game-high four blocks in the loss to Bowling Green, the 45th time in his career he has led the team in blocked shots for a game... The game against Bowling Green Dec. 12, is the final home date for the Blue and Gold during the 2009 calendar year... Canisius will embark on a stretch where they play six straight away from the Koessler Athletic Center, starting Dec. 16, when the team plays at Duquesne at 7:30 p.m.

Fairfield posted a pair of wins last week, running its winning streak to four games and improving to a conference-best 8-2... Head Coach **Ed Cooley** has the team off to its best 10-game start in more than 30 years, as the 1977-78 squad won nine of its first 10 outings en route to a 22-5 season and a NIT berth... The Stags had two student athletes average a double double last week... Senior center **Anthony Johnson** finished the two-game run with 18.5 points and 11 rebounds per game, while freshman guard Derek Needham tallied 11.5 points and 10 assists per game in the two wins... Needham tallied 14 assists against Sacred Heart, raising the freshman's assist average to 5.8 per game... He currently leads all freshmen in the MAAC in assists as well as in scoring (15.7 ppg)... While Johnson and Needham averaged a double double last week, it should not overshadow that fact that **Yorel Hawkins** was the team's top scorer in the two games with 19.5 points per game... Hawkins is the team's top overall scorer with 16.7 points per game after missing the first three games of the year with injury... All five Fairfield starters reached double figures in Fairfield's 93-77 win against Sacred Heart, while reserve **Mike Evanovich** also reached double digits to give the Stags six student athletes with 10 or more points in the game... The combination of six players allowed Fairfield to score the most points in a game under Coach Cooley at 93, and the most since a 109-108 win at the Arena against Saint Peter's during the 2005-06 campaign.

The Gaels won two of three contests this week topping Long Island University at home and the BIG EAST's Providence on the road after falling to Siena on Monday... The Gaels earned their largest margin of victory of the season in an 80-64 win over the Blackbirds on Wednesday night... Iona snapped a five-game losing streak to BIG EAST opponents in an 82-73 win at Providence on Saturday night... The Gaels last win came on Dec. 27, 2001 over Seton Hall at the MSG Holiday Festival... Freshman **Kyle Smyth** led the Gaels in scoring in both Iona wins this week netting 18 points vs. LIU and a career-high 21 in the victory over the BIG EAST's Providence... He averaged 15.7 points and 5.0 rebounds over the Gaels' three games this week and added seven assists... Sophomore **Scott Machado** added 11.0 points per game along with a team-best 3.3 assists... Senior **Jonathan Huffman** recorded 11 points and a season-high seven rebounds vs. the Friars... The Gaels improved to 5-0 when Smyth records 10 or more points and 4-0 when they score 80 or more as a team... Iona is now 7-1 in 80+ point games under head coach **Kevin Willard**... The Gaels have one contest this week when they host Albany on Thursday night... The Maroon & Gold then embarks on a season-long six-game road trip that wraps around the New Year.

Loyola dropped its third straight, falling in overtime at Coppin State, 63-58... The defeat was the Greyhounds' first after six straight overtime victories, five of those under head coach **Jimmy Patsos**... Shooting was Loyola's undoing, connecting on just 28.4 percent (19-67) for the game and 18.5 percent (5-27) from three-point range... Junior guard **Jamal Barney** led the Greyhounds with 16 points, but took 19 shots to get there and misfired on all eight of his three-point attempts... Senior guard **Brett Harvey** was the only other Loyola player in double figures with 10... Sophomore forward **Anthony Winbush** scored eight points and added eight rebounds, his rebounding total being matched by sophomore forward **Shane Walker**... The Greyhounds blocked nine Eagles shots, matching the second-highest total in school history... Through nine games, Loyola has blocked fewer than three shots in a game only once and the 43 total blocks already ranks among the top 25 season performances in school annals... The Greyhounds are off for exams, playing its next game on December 19 when they host Howard in Reitz Arena at 1 o'clock... The game will be televised regionally on MASN.

The Jaspers fell 44-39 at Hofstra on Wednesday in a defensive battle... Manhattan forced the Pride into 19 turnovers, but suffered from a poor shooting performance (21.4%)... Manhattan guards **Patrick Bouli** and **Rico Pickett** led the offensive effort with 10 points in their second loss to a Colonial Athletic Association member this season... The Jaspers dropped its second game of the week on Saturday at two-time defending Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference champion Morgan State, 83-74... Five Jaspers scored in double figures, including a 24 point and seven rebound effort from Crawford... Junior center **Laurence Jolicoeur** scored a season-best 15 points, while **Antoine Pearson** (12), **Brandon Adams** (10) and Pickett (10) also contributed to the effort... Pearson went over the 1,000-point plateau to become the 32nd player in program history to reach this milestone... Manhattan is in the middle of a seven-game road series... The Jaspers return to action on Saturday at Long Island when they attempt to snap a two-game skid... Tip off is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. in Brooklyn.

Marist dropped its lone contest of last week, suffering an 88-72 defeat to preseason America East favorite Boston University in its home opener on Dec. 12... The loss dropped the Red Foxes to 0-7 on the season... The Red Foxes' home opener came after six consecutive road games to start the season, a program-record total... Marist had three double-digits scorers against the Terriers, and all three were freshmen... Guard **Candon Rusin** led the way with a career-high 15 points, shooting 5-for-9 from the field and 3-for-6 from three-point range... Forward **Rob Johnson** scored 13 points... Guard **Devin Price** poured in a career-high 12 on 4-for-5 shooting from the field and a 2-for-3 effort from three-point range... Price also contributed two steals and two assists... In all, Marist freshmen have accounted for 55.6 percent (224 of 403) points scored this season... The Red Foxes have also started three freshmen (Rusin, Johnson and Sam Prescott) in each of their last four games... Johnson and Prescott have started all seven of the Red Foxes' games so far this season... Marist has now hit a three-pointer in 299 consecutive games... The Red Foxes will be in action once this week, when they host Binghamton of the America East Conference on Sunday, Dec. 20 at 4 p.m. ... Binghamton is the fourth of five America East foes Marist will face this season.

The Purple Eagles handed Illinois State its first loss of the season on Sunday with a 76-68 road win ... Niagara shot 46.3 percent from the floor and 47.6 percent from behind the arc to counter the rebounding deficit ... The Redbirds dominated the glass, 49-28, but the Purple Eagles owned the perimeter, shooting 10-of-21 from outside ... **Tyrone Lewis** had a record-breaking week for the Purple Eagles ... On Wednesday, the 5-foot-11 guard broke the school's career record for 3-pointers made while connecting on a career-best six triples ... Lewis' 227 3PM topped his old teammate Lorenzo Miles' total of 220 ... On Sunday, Lewis would not let the Purple Eagles lose a tough road game at Illinois State, connecting on five 3-pointers, including back-to-back triples in a 25 second span to put the game out of reach ... Lewis tallied 26 points in both contests, and became just the 11th Purple Eagle to eclipse the 1,500-point mark at Niagara ... The win at Illinois State was extra special, playing without All-MAAC First Team performer **Bilal Benn** ... Before Sunday's game, Illinois State was 7-0 and owned a 34-4 record at home since the start of the 2007-08 season ... **Kashief Edwards** is making his presence felt on both ends of the floor ... He blocked four shots for the fifth time this season on Sunday, and the 6-foot-6 forward is averaging 11.5 ppg over his past six contests, including matching his career-high of 14 points against Illinois State.

Thompson moved into ninth place on Rider's all-time scoring list (1,479), passing Rider Hall of Famer Greg Burston '99 ... Burston was sixth (1,472) when he graduated ... Rider has won four of its last five and five of last seven games ... Also at UMBC, junior guard **Justin Robinson** made all four of his foul shots and has now made 19 in a row ... Robinson leads the MAAC in free throw shooting, making 31 of 34 ... The UMBC game was the first of six straight road games ... Rider is 2-2 on the road this year ... The Broncs travel to Rutgers Tuesday ... Last time Rider traveled to Piscataway, the Broncs defeated Rutgers 61-57 on December 21, 2007 ... Rider is 6-0 this year when leading with 10 minutes left in the game ... Last year Rider was 11-1 when leading with 10 minutes left ... Against La Salle Rider lost in Alumni Gym for the first time this year and just the fifth time in the last 31 games ... The last time Rider lost in Alumni Gym was January 30, 2009, 10 home games ago ... In the second half, Rider out-rebounded the much taller Explorers 23-15 and out-scored La Salle 35-31 in the second half ... Philadelphia native **Novar Gadson** scored 14 points and grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds against the Explorers.

The Peacocks led for most of the game, but allowed the Highlanders to draw within two with 4:57 to play ... Saint Peter's then went on an 11-2, sparked by a **Nick Leon** three-pointer, to up their lead to 13 and put the contest away ... **Wesley Jenkins** led all scorers with a game-high 25 points for Saint Peter's ... Jenkins was 8-15 from the field, including 2-5 from beyond the arch and 7-8 from the line ... He also had four rebounds, three blocks and two steals ... Leon finished with 14 points and three rebounds, while **Darius Conley** had 11 points, six boards and five assists ... On Saturday, the Peacocks suffered a 59-58 defeat at the hands of previous winless Wagner ... The Peacocks led for most of the contest, but Wagner took their first lead after a 6-0 at the 10:50 mark of the first half, and then scored six straight points in the final 1:15 to get the victory ... Conley recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds to lead Saint Peter's ... Conley was 4-9 from the field with a block and two steals ... **Jeron Belin** and **Jenkins** each added 10 points each ... Jenkins leads the Peacocks with 15.0 ppg, while Leon is scoring 11.7 ppg ... Saint Peter's will play one game this week, on Saturday night at Fairleigh Dickinson.

Siena has won six of its 10 games this season and now enjoys a 12-day rest for final exams before resuming MAAC play against Rider at Times Union Center December 23 ... That game starts a four-game homestand and a stretch in which Siena will play six of seven games and eight of 10 at home ... That is good news, as the team entered the week with a 24-game winning streak that ties for the third longest in the nation ... Siena opened its MAAC season with a 13-point win at Iona ... It was the team's 38th victory in its last 46 league contests, and 15th win in its last 19 road MAAC games ... The Saints missed another opportunity to bolster their resume on Saturday when they allowed MVC favorite Northern Iowa to shoot 62% from the field in the second half in an 82-65 loss in Cedar Falls ... Siena's four losses have come against quality opposition (Temple, St. John's, Georgia Tech and UNI), but the Saints were in all four games and allowed all four teams to shoot 60% or better from the field after intermission ... Four starters are averaging 11 points or better, and the fifth, senior point guard **Ronald Moore**, leads the nation with eight assists per game ... Siena's bench may receive a boost when transfer **Kyle Griffin** becomes eligible for the Rider game, and freshman **Davis Martens** becomes eligible for the Saint Peter's game New Year's Eve.
